
The Core of the Blueprint

(Chandler & Frank, 2015)

- Blueprint at its core is about designing and strengthening school systems as learning organizations for turnaround.
- Acceleration requires instructional improvement at scale. Therefore, acceleration must be framed as a problem of organizational learning nested within the systems designed to support it.
- Each system component at the district level, then, is about the installation of institutional structures and practices to improve instructional practice at scale that leads to improved academic, social, emotional, and health outcomes for students.
- Each building-level component, then, is about instructional routines for both instructional leaders (principal, coach, specialist) and teachers that follow well-designed patterns of interaction meant to support organizational change.

Research...

 National and International researchers have recently focused their efforts at the district or system level as it is the district's responsibility to lead instructional improvement and to create the systems needed to support that improvement while eliminating barriers and obstacles to that improvement (Lane, 2013).




