- Students also learned basic shop safety and tool usage

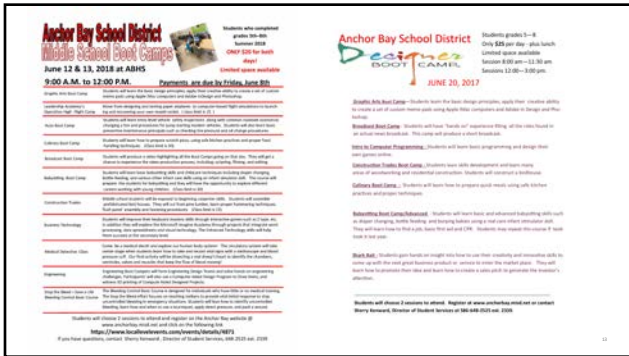

Career Fair and CTE Showcase

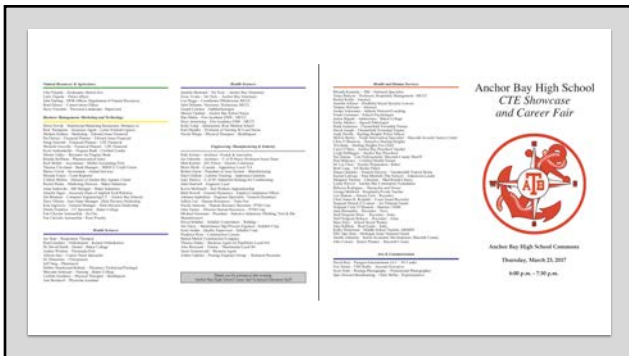
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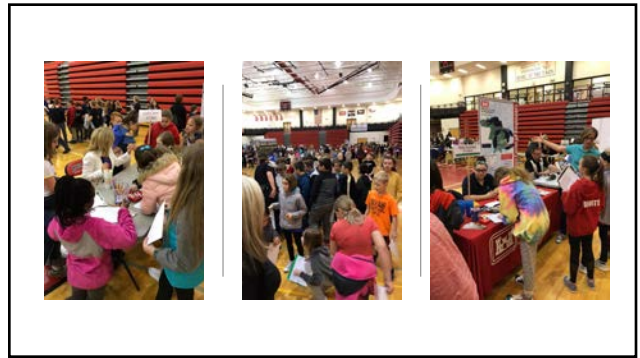
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Middle School CTE Tours
