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Michigan Requirements

Major Components & Alignment in Xello

How students build & revise required components:

- ✓ **Educational Development Plan:** Living documents developed by students from 7th-12th grade to identify career goals, and related action plans that align with changing interests and abilities.
- ✓ **Talent Portfolios:** As students develop/improve their marketable skills, they can add these experiences, proficiencies, certifications, etc.. to showcase their accomplishments.
- ✓ **4-Year Plans:** Each student makes their course selection in Xello, ensuring visibility into whether they are on track to graduate and aware of potential pathways. Connect with your Success Manager to learn more.



Updates to the CDM

- ✓ **Updated Career Development Targets and Strategies**
Detailed, grade-specific career development targets designed to guide students from early childhood through postsecondary education.
- ✓ **Enhanced Family and Community Engagement**
Encouraging schools to actively involve families and local stakeholders in students' career exploration and planning.
- ✓ **Updated Workforce Development Initiatives**
The new Workforce requirements mandate real time tracking & reporting on students WBL initiatives.

CDM vs EDP

Purpose

- **CDM:** Provides a framework for schools to design and deliver career development programs.
- **EDP:** Serves as a personalized plan that guides a student's career and academic decisions.

Scope

- **CDM:** Broad and systemic, used across schools and districts.
- **EDP:** Focused on the individual student.

Focus

- **CDM:** Emphasizes the overall career education environment and programming.
- **EDP:** Concentrates on the student's goals, interests, and course selections.






About Me



Students connect the pieces in Goals & Plans



- Export course requests for scheduling in your student information system (SIS).






Xello Portfolios

Portfolios allow students to create and share their accomplishments, and showcase their work across subjects.


Students can:

- **Saved careers & clusters**

- **Saved plans**
Strategic planning (align supports and resources), counseling support, equity insights, partnership development.
- **Saved scholarships**
Post-secondary planning, counselor support, equity monitoring.
- **Saved colleges**
College visit planning, support personalized planning, help identify supports needed.
- **Course planner reports**
Identify trends and strengthen program development, capacity planning, support academic planning, identify mismatches and gaps


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Michigan Completion Standards

Michigan Completion Standards and Student Task List

Guide students towards their CCR goals with greater clarity, structure and accountability

- Empowers districts to tailor activity and tasks for each grade level.
 - Educators can prompt students to retake assessments and assign tasks to student groups for personalized and targeted development
 - Streamlined reporting interface that lets educators quickly view overall progress broken down by student, task, grade, school, or group




